The Bob Cork Perpetual Trophy to be presented to the Best Somerset Produced Cider in Show from the winner of classes 100 to 104 and 105 -108

Rules:

1. Entries are restricted to two per class.
2. Cider and Perry must have been made in 2018 (except for classes 106, 107 and 108) and conform to HMRC Notice 162. Entries may be sweetened with sugar only.
3. Entries for Classes 100 to 102 to be presented in one gallon demijohns, bearing a tie-on label stating class and entry number.
4. Entries for Classes 103, 104, 106, 107, and 108 to be presented in two clear glass, screw top, 75cl bottles each bearing a tie-on label stating class and entry number. The variety of apple used in Class 4, Single Variety Cider, to be stated on the label.
5. Entries for Class 6 to be presented in two 75cl glass Champagne style bottles, stoppered and wired, bearing a tie-on label stating class and entry number.
6. All entry forms and fees must be received by Friday 27th July.
- 7. Class and entry numbers will be sent to entrants by the Show Secretary.**
8. Entries to be delivered to the Show by 9am on Sunday 19th August or Saturday 18th August between 11am and 4pm.
9. Judging will commence at 9.15am on the morning of the Show.
10. Cider and Perry must be the product of the entrant and not obtained from elsewhere.
11. The Judges' decision will be final.
12. The Judges reserve the right not to award a prize or certificate if, for example, it is considered that the entries do not meet the required standard.
13. All cider and perry entries must be collected by 6pm on the day of the Show, if not they will be disposed of by the Show Stewards.
14. Prize money is available from the Secretary's Office on Show Day. If you are unable to collect your prize money in person on Show Day. It will be forwarded to you within 2 weeks of Show Day.
15. Verbal feedback on entries can be given to competitors, if requested, when judging is complete. Please notify the Chief Stewards.

Class 106	Open Class - Dry, S.G up to 1.005
Class 107	Open Class - Medium, S.G 1.005 - 1.012
Class 108	Open Class - Sweet, S.G greater than 1.012
