Class SJ1 Connolly's RED Mills Senior Newcomers – First round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Table A7.325mpm. Start Height 1.10m

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS. In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money will be awarded.

Horses/ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule – 76.6.

In Category 2 Shows the class must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

In Category 2 Shows the class must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1 This show is affiliated to the British Show Jumping Association. All classes will be judged in accordance with British Showjumping Rules.

- 2 Entries close on **FRIDAY 9th AUGUST 2019**. Telephone entries will not be accepted under any circumstances. Late entries will be accepted on the day subject to classes not being full and a late payment of £2 extra per class.
- 3 The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason.
- 4 All competitors take part at their own risk. The organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any accident which may occur to any horse, rider, spectator or property.
- 5 The Society shall not be liable for any damage to vehicles that may occur while being towed onto or off the showground.
- 6 The decision of the organisers on any point not covered in the rules is **FINAL**.
- 7 Protective headgear, as British Showjumping Rule 101.3, must be worn whilst mounted on the showground. See also Rule 267.
- 8 Full entry fees must be submitted with each entry. Refunds will be made in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79.5.
- 9 Dogs will only be allowed on the showground if kept on leads or within competitor's vehicles.
- 10 In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6
- 11 The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and competitors must obey the instructions of the organiser, officials and stewards.
- 12 In accordance with Rule 102.13 no member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete, or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 13 **EQUINE FLU** – Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21 – 92 days later), followed by the first booster (150 - 215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose.

Horses must have been vaccinated within 6 months before the Show but, not less than 7 days of arriving at the Show.
- 14 The Mid-Somerset Show Rules and Conditions will be displayed in the Show Jumping Secretary's tent, please ensure that you read them.
